Wood Raffle Dates Friday 20th May, Friday 10th June, Friday 8th July & Friday 5th August. We will need ticket sellers for these dates.

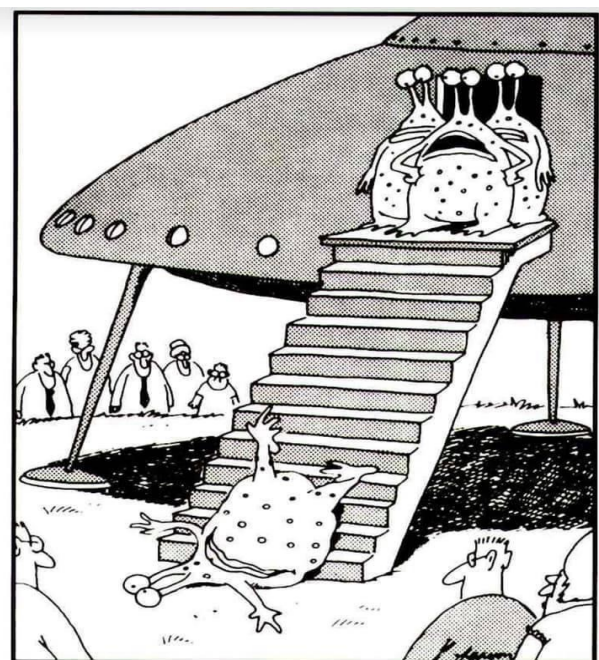
International Rotary Convention is to be held in Melbourne this year on 23rd May. Great opportunity to attend.
